brute	7	an animal; a beast; a cruel or wild creature; one who lacks human sensibilities and intelligence; one who is not civilised
cider	6	a drink or beverage made from fruit, most often apples; a liquid used to make vinegar
crater	5	a basin-like mouth, opening, or hole, as of a volcano or geyser; a deep depression in the ground
dozed	6	slept lightly; napped; slumbered; snoozed; slept for a short period of time
entirely	5	wholly; completely; fully; totally
fantastic	6	wonderful; great; excellent; marvellous; causing a feeling of awe or wonder
flask	7	a small bottle or container that usually holds liquid
furiously	7	angrily or vehemently; in a way that shows great excitement or anger
murky	8	dark and gloomy; cloudy; unclear; muddy
respectable	8	proper and polite; having a good reputation; considered decent, appropriate, moral, or correct; worthy of honor and admiration
